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Index: key to abbreviations

Categories of registration

Diploma Programme candidates must register in one of four categories. These are identified by one of the following letters.

- D** **Diploma:** candidates intending to complete the requirements for the award of an IB diploma.
- R** **Retake:** previous IB diploma candidates who are seeking to improve their results. The highest grade obtained for a subject will contribute towards the IB diploma.
- C** **Certificate:** candidates taking one or more subjects who are not seeking the award of the IB diploma.
- A** **Anticipated:** candidates intending to complete the requirements for one or two standard level subjects (excluding languages *ab initio* and pilot subjects) at the end of their first year of the Diploma Programme. They must complete all remaining IB diploma requirements in the corresponding examination session in the following year.

Schools that are authorized to offer the IB Diploma Programme are grouped by geographical region. The abbreviations used in the tables are the codes describing the following geographical regions:

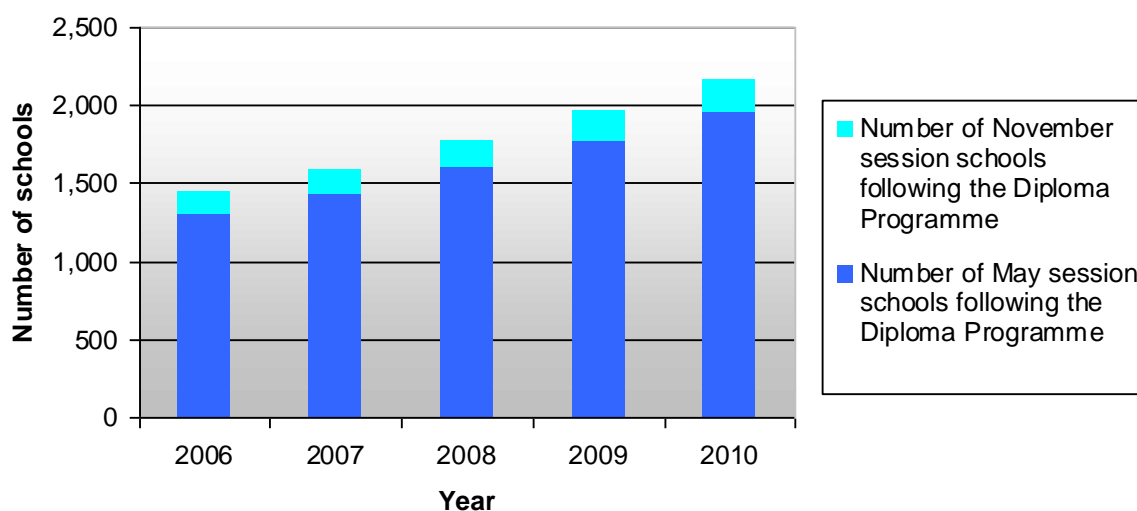

Graph 1.1 Number of schools following the Diploma Programme 2006–2010

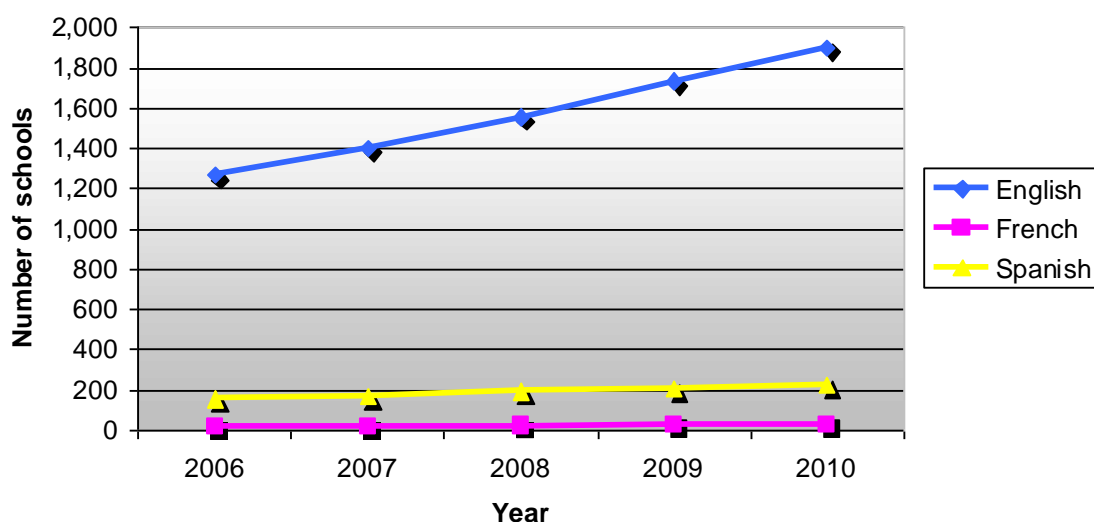

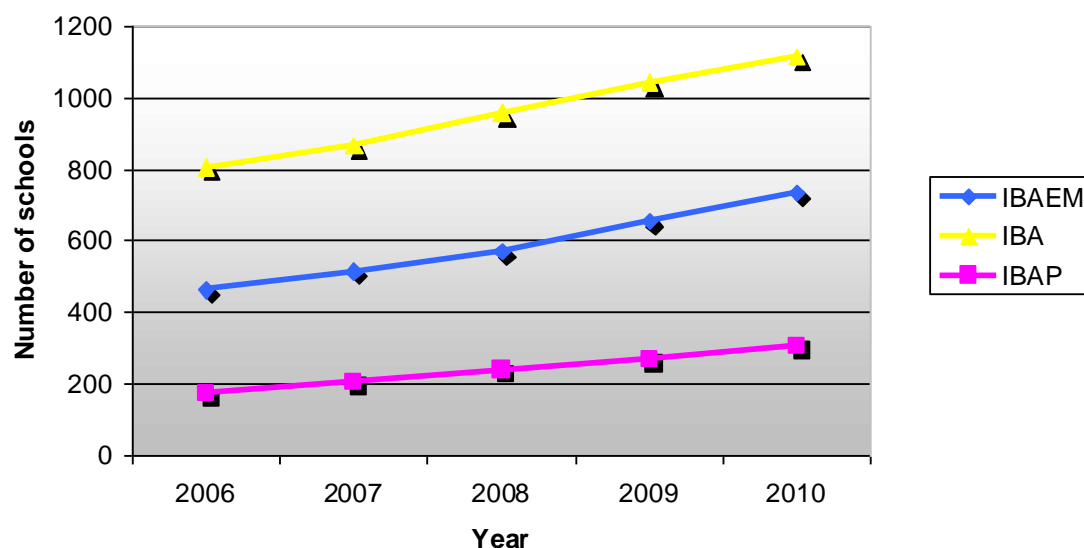

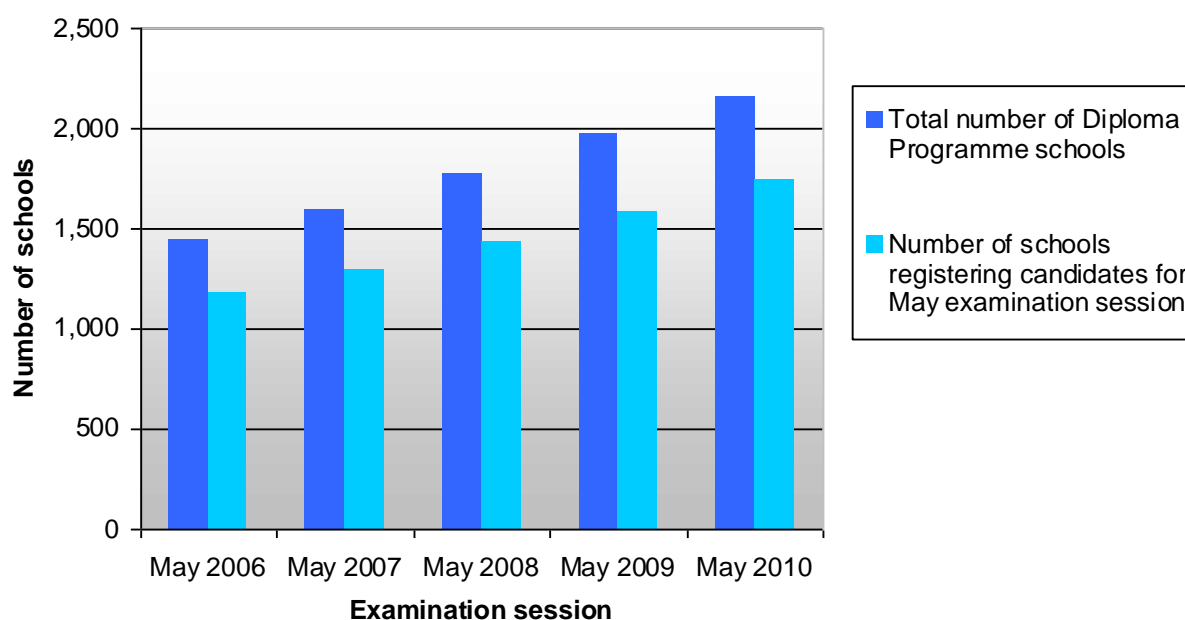

Graph 4.1 Number of schools registering candidates May 2006–May 2010



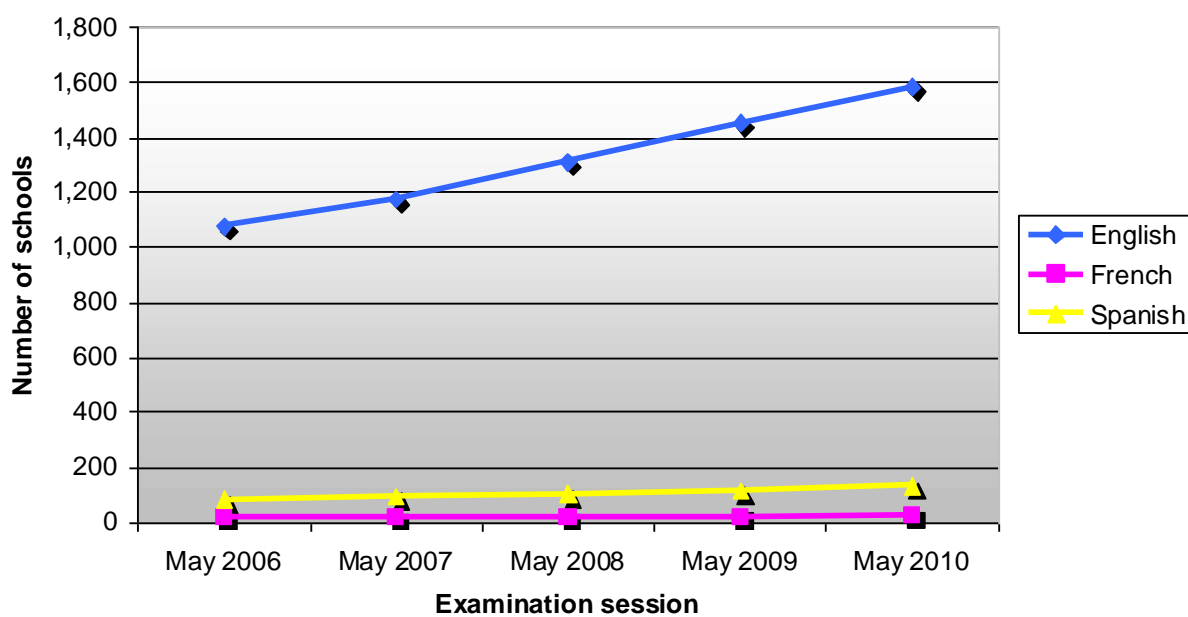

Graph 6.1 Number of schools registering candidates by working language May 2006–May 2010

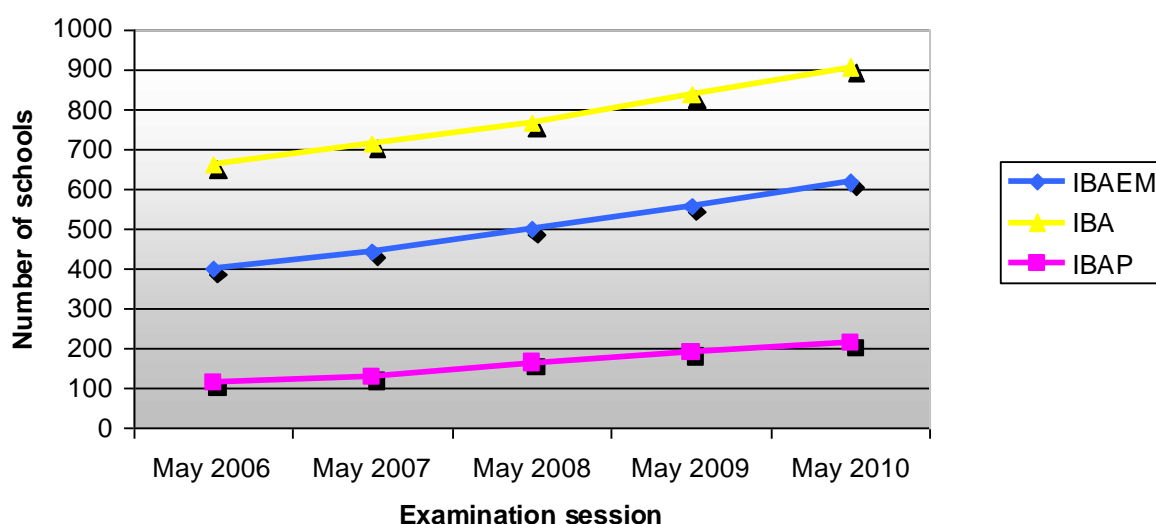

Graph 7.1 Number of schools registering candidates by IB region May 2006–May 2010



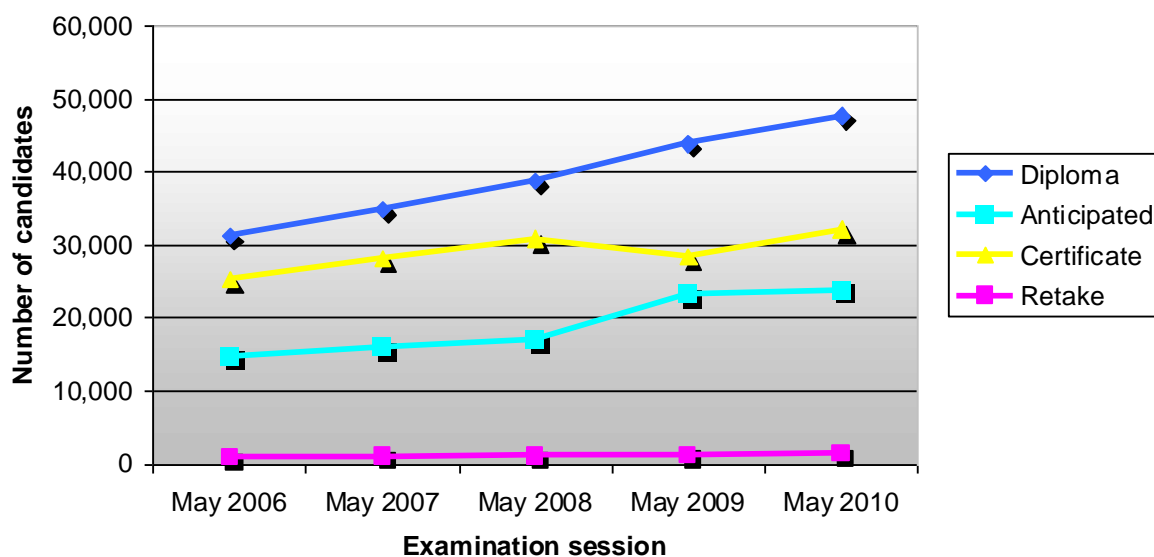

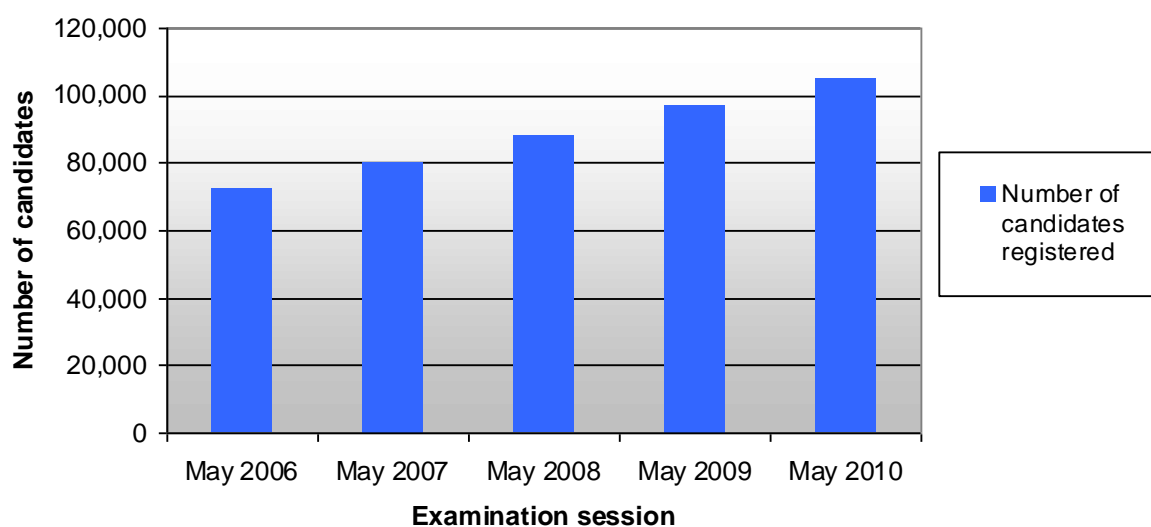

Graph 8.1 Number of candidates registered by category May 2006–May 2010



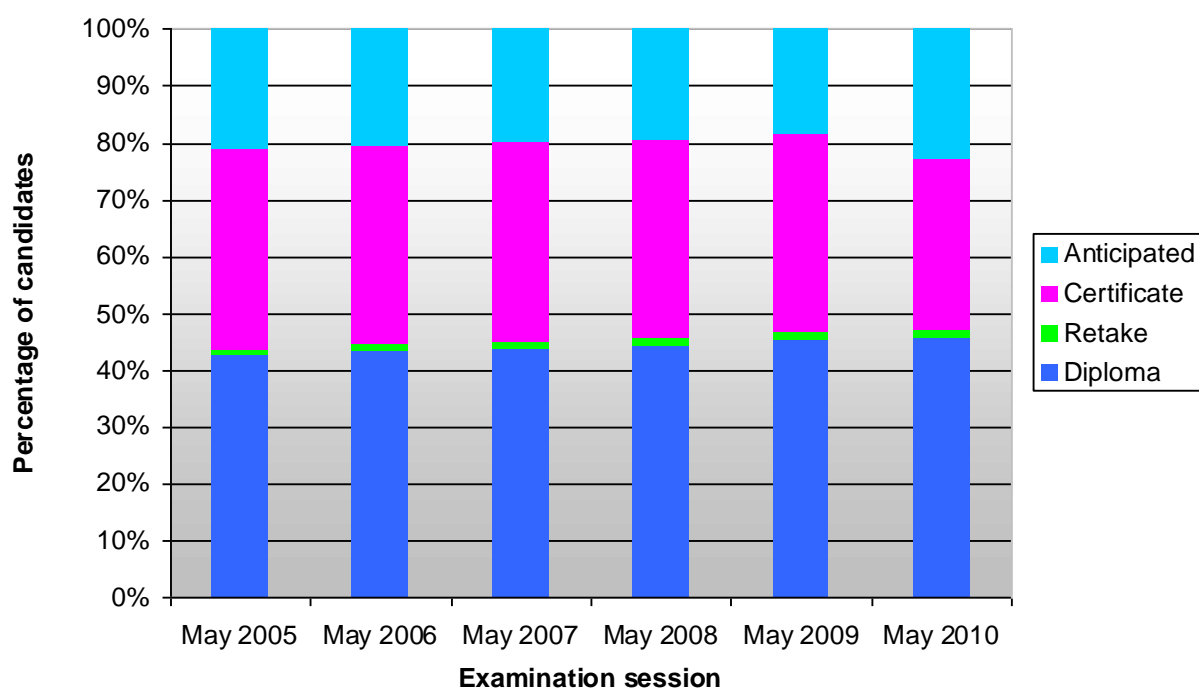
Graph 8.2 Number of candidates registered May 2006–May 2010

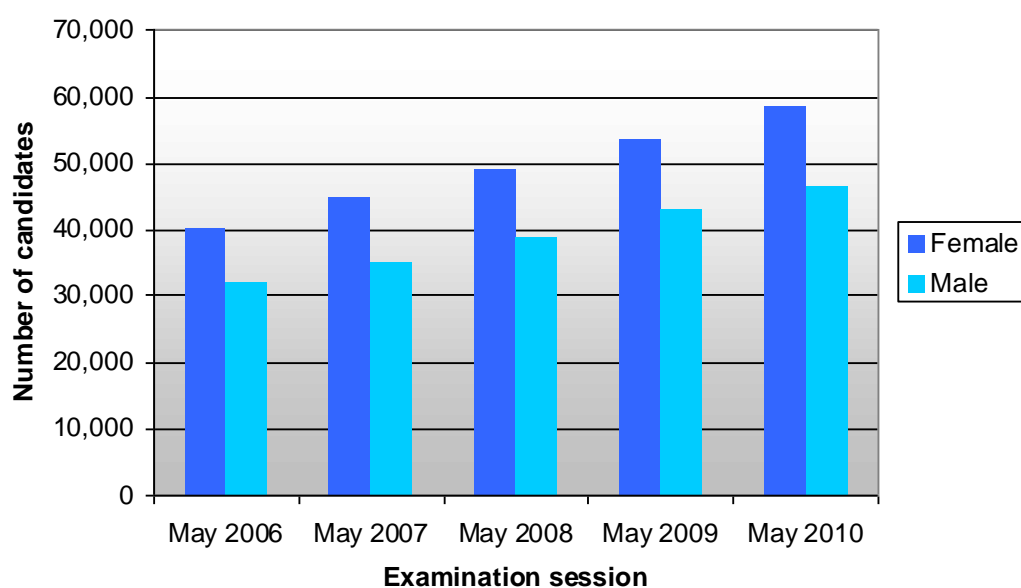
Graph 8.3 Percentages of candidates registered May 2006–May 2010

Graph 9.1 Number of candidates registered by gender May 2005–May 2009

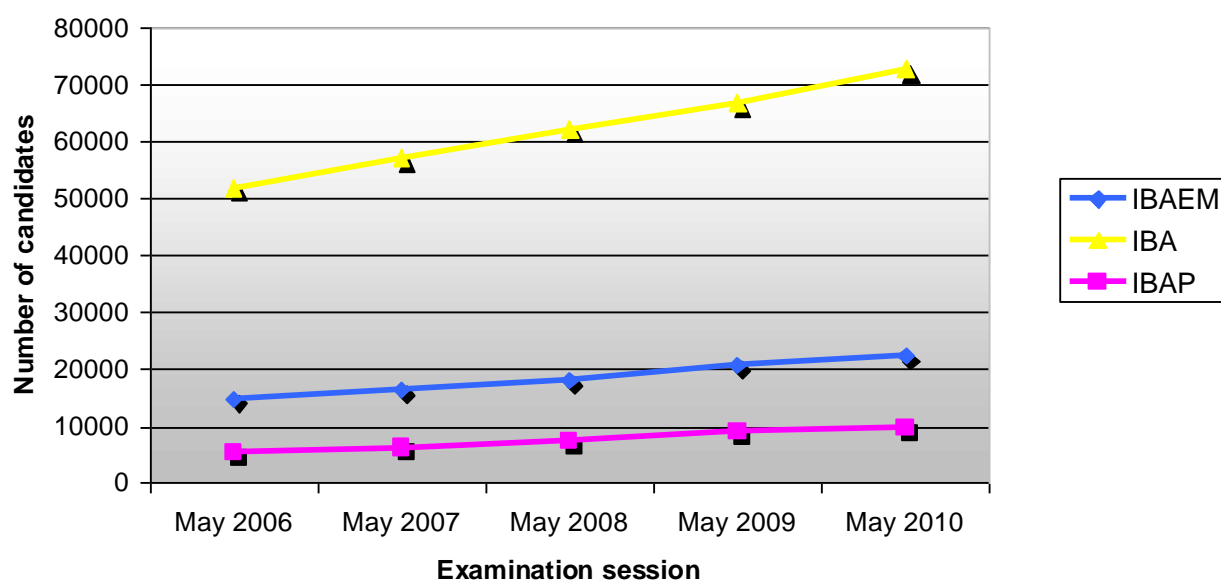

Graph 10.1 Number of candidates registered by IB region May 2006–May 2010

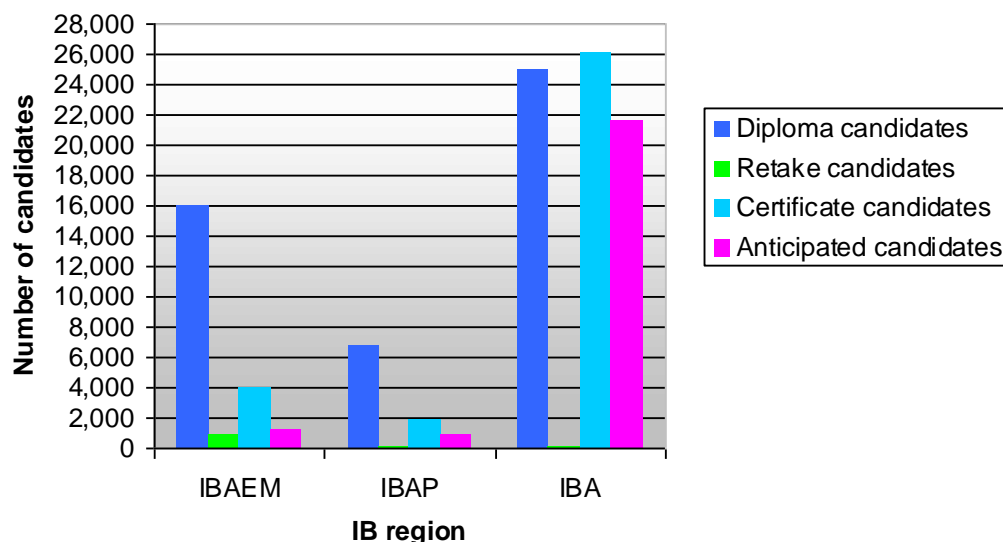

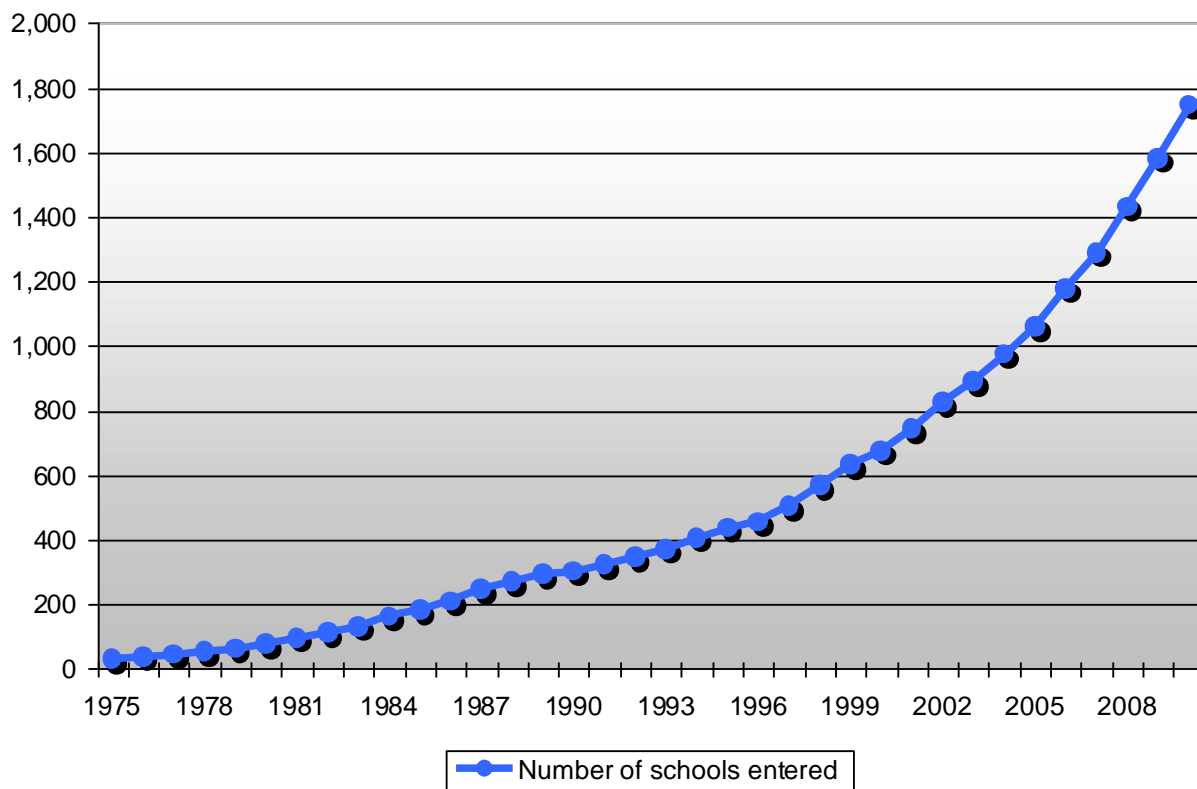
Graph 11.1 Number of candidates registered by category and IB region May 2010



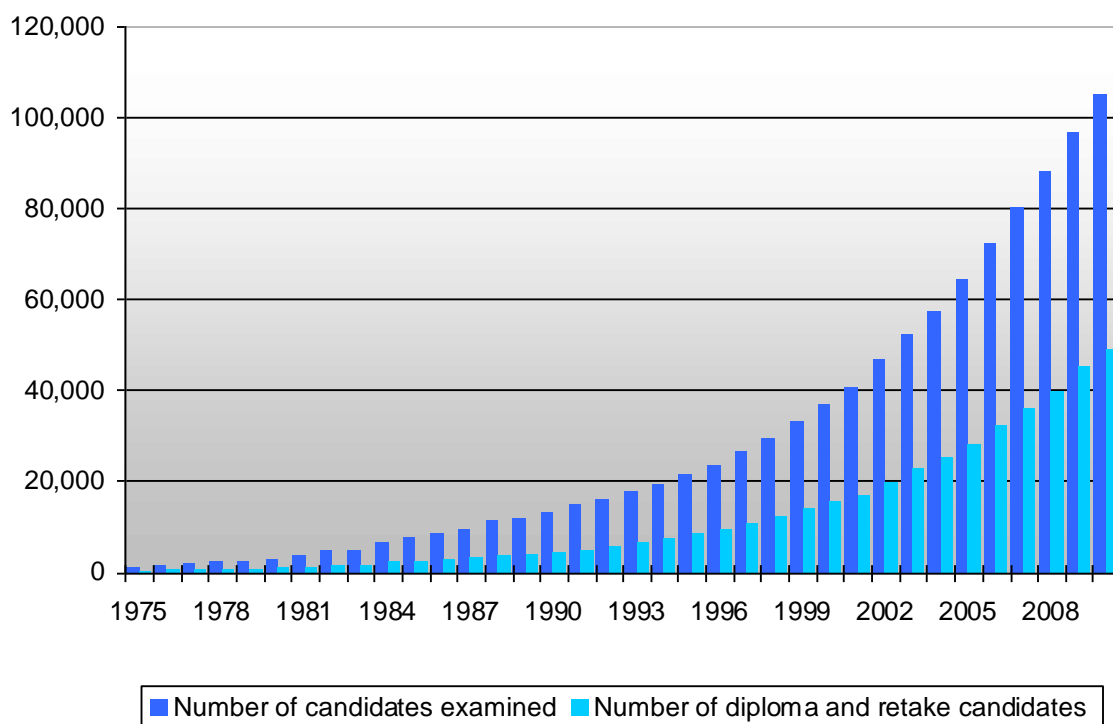

Graph 12.1 Summary of Diploma Programme examination entries: schools with candidates registered May 1975–May 2010



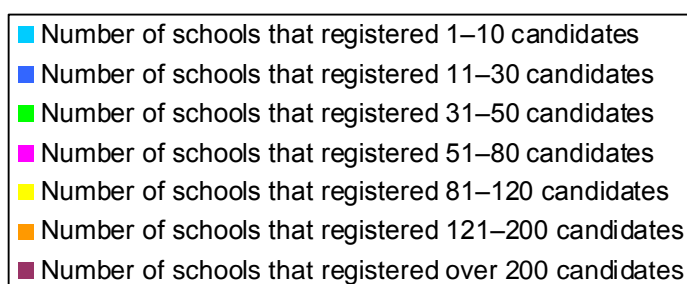
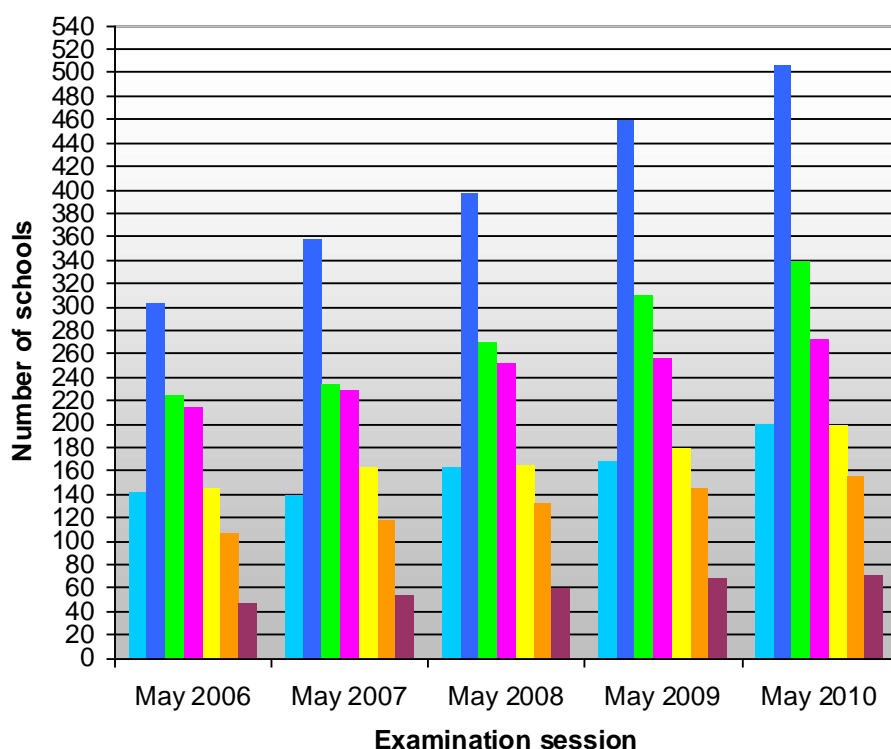
Graph 12.2 Summary of Diploma Programme examination entries: total number of candidates registered; number of diploma and retake candidates registered May 1975–May 2010

Graph 13.1 Number of schools that registered a particular number of candidates May 2006–May 2010



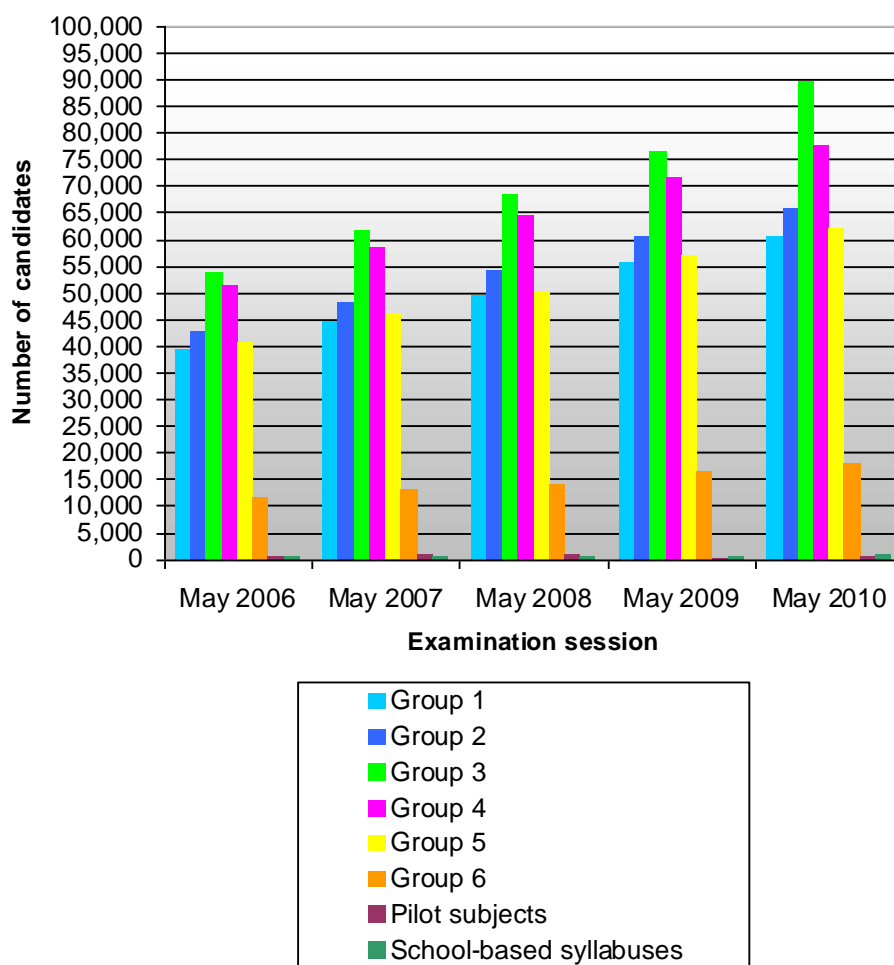

Graph 15.1 Number of candidates registered for subject groups May 2006–May 2010



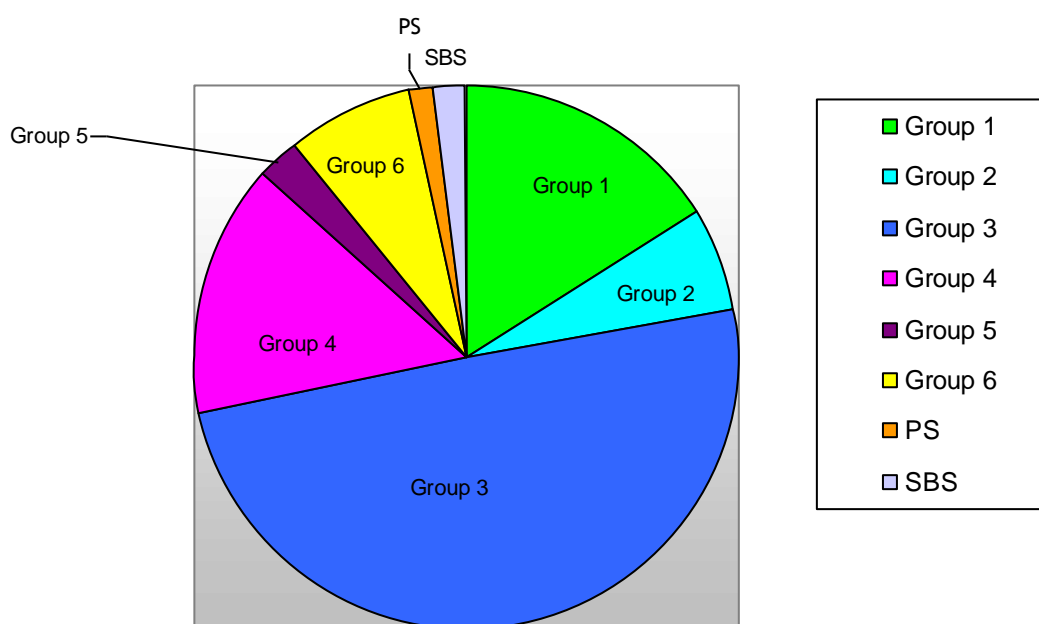

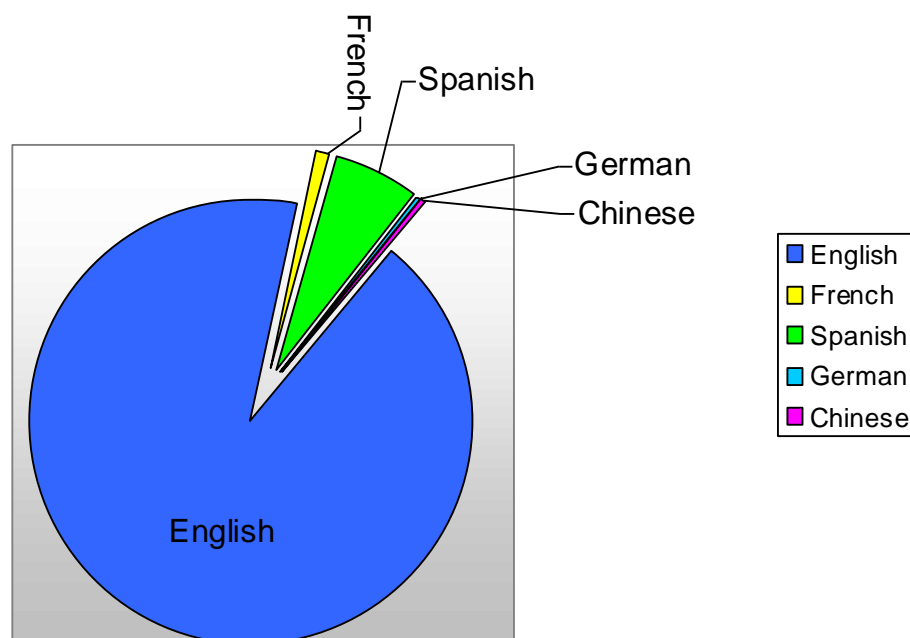
Graph 17.1 Subject registration summary: extended essay by subject group May 2010

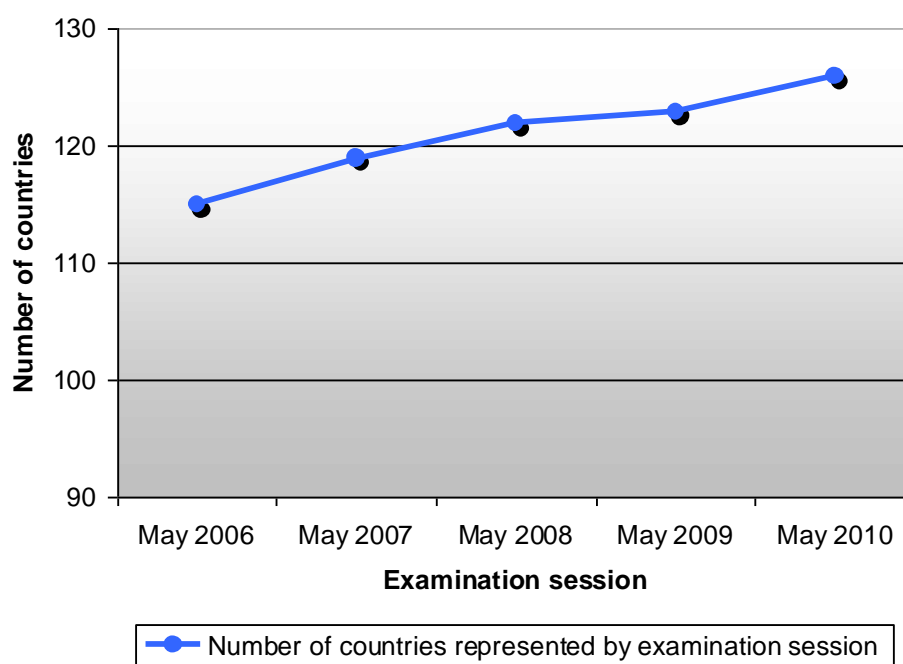

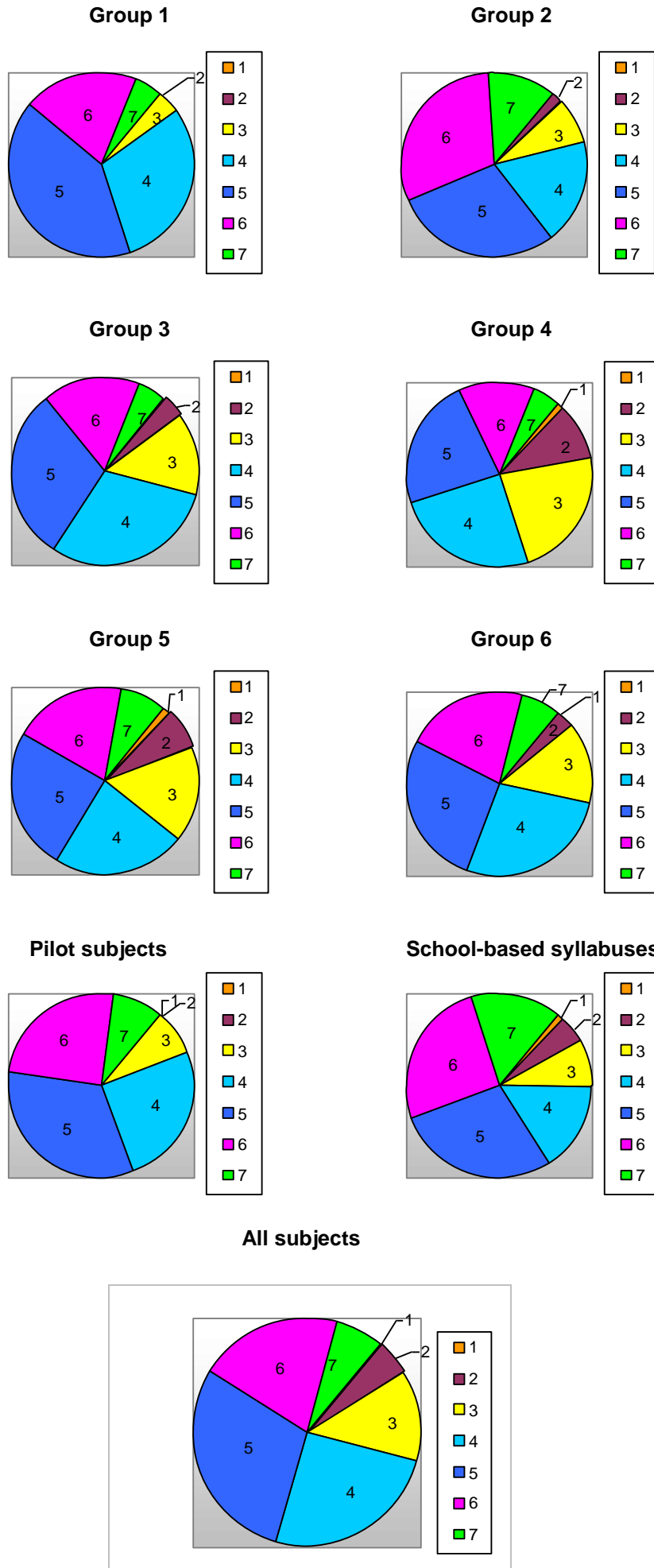

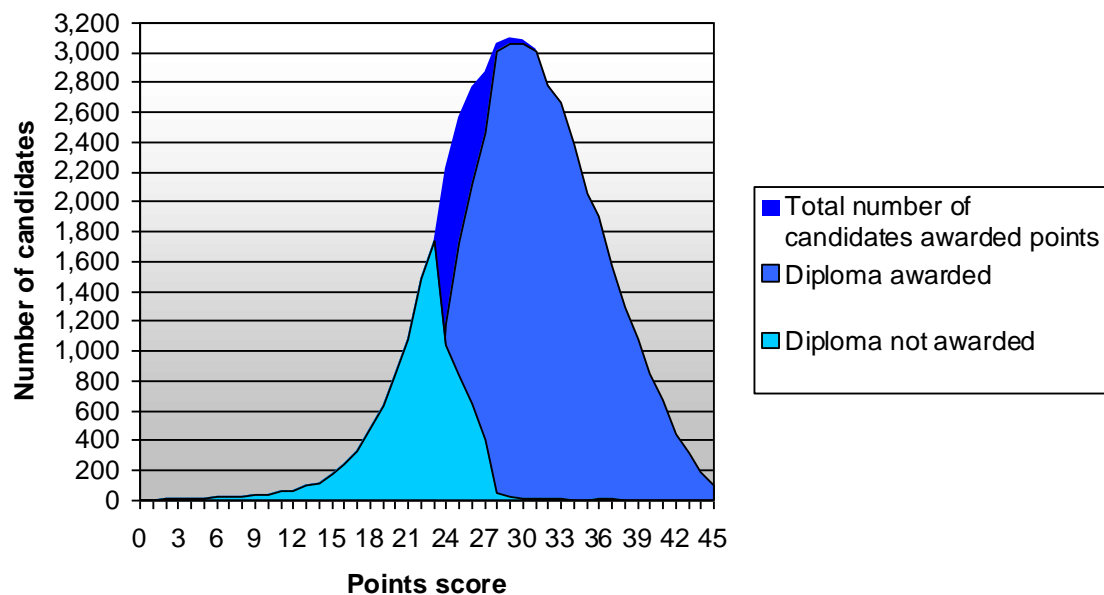

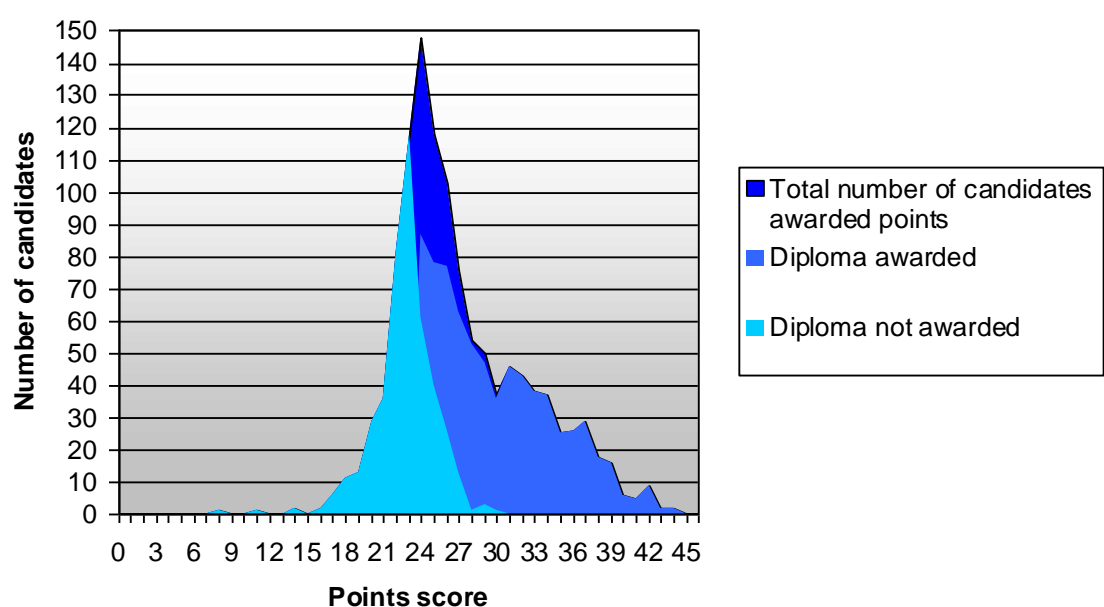

Graph 25.1 Number of diploma and retake candidates with diplomas awarded and diplomas not awarded per points score May 2010



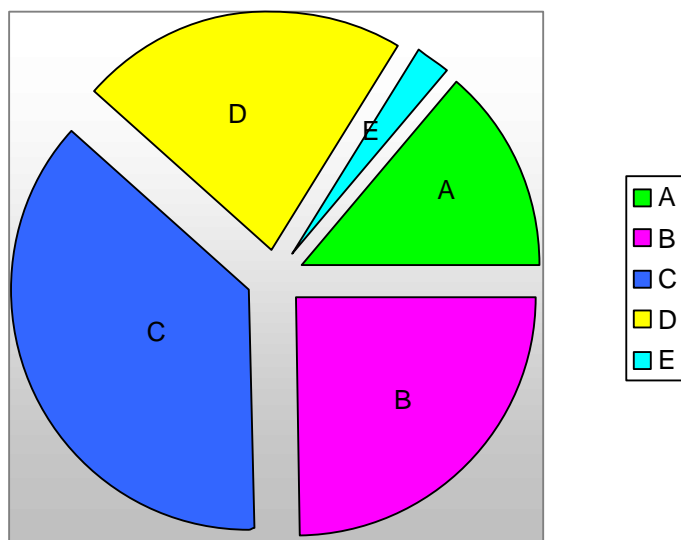
Graph 25.2 Number of retake candidates only with diplomas awarded and diplomas not awarded per points score May 2010



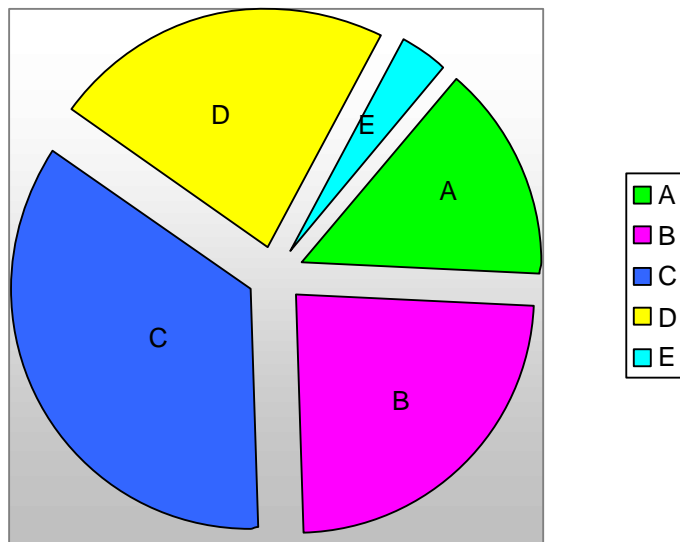

Graph 26.1 Percentage of grades awarded: extended essay May 2010



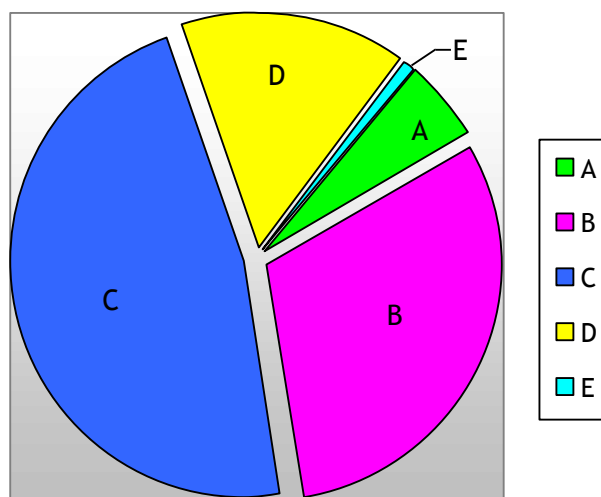
Graph 26.2 Percentage of grades awarded: extended essay May 2009



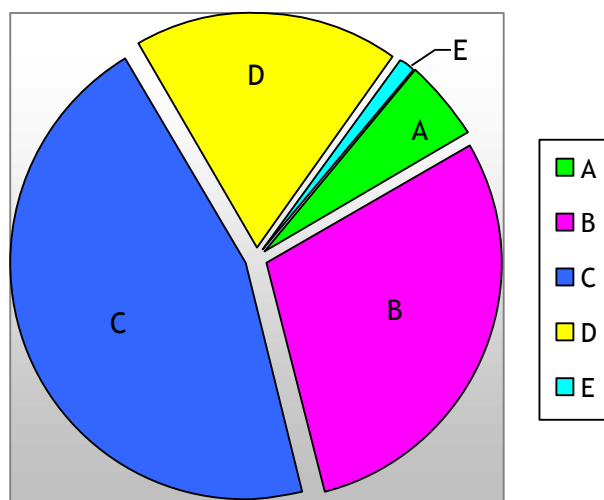

Graph 27.1 Percentage of grades awarded: theory of knowledge May 2010



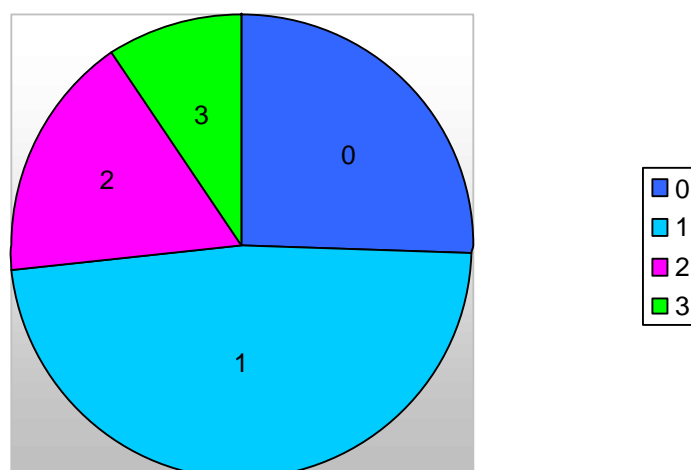
Graph 27.2 Percentage of grades awarded: theory of knowledge May 2009



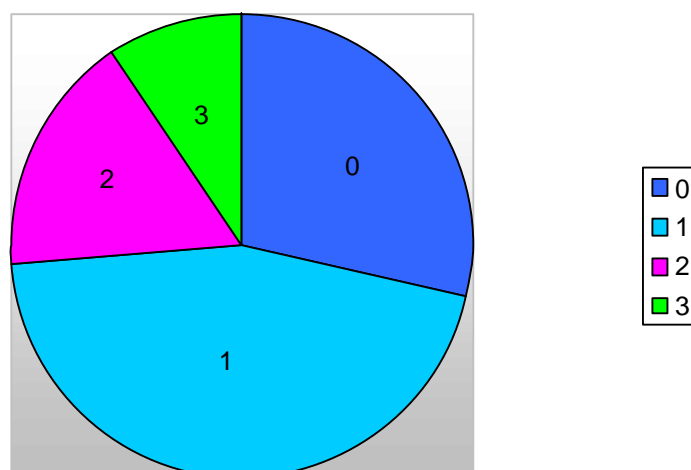
