Write **at least** 400 words on **one** of the following:

1. A travel magazine has recently published an article on the theme: “People should see their own countries first before visiting others”. This article made such an impression on you that you have decided to write a response to it. Write a letter to the editor either agreeing or disagreeing with this article.
 2. A sports magazine has just announced a contest to select the next site for an important youth sports competition. Write a proposal nominating your city or a city you have visited for this honour. Explain the reasons why this city should be selected including the benefits for the city itself.
 3. You have been put in charge of a school event (*e.g.* a school play, a competition, or a school trip). To promote student participation, write a brochure describing the event and how it will benefit the students.
 4. Your class read an article on the following topic: “A person should be judged by what they are on the inside rather than on how they look on the outside”. Because of the lively discussion which followed, an essay was set on this topic. Write your essay.
 5. You have been asked to interview a fellow student who designed an unusual summer camp experience for young people that took place last year. This camp was very successful. Write an article for your school newspaper based on this interview describing the camp and which aspects made it a success.
 6. Characters in a work of literature are often the reason why this work becomes well known. In a review for a monthly magazine for young adults, write a description of a character that you have encountered in your reading and explain why that character made the work memorable. Make sure you mention the title of the book and the name of the character.
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
